AP English Literature or Language (ENG 101 and ENG 102 with score of 4 or 5) counts for 6 CSU credits and Gen.Ed.08 Writing/Composition. 15 credits total must be taken during summer sessions, 6 in year 1, 6 in year 2, and 3 in year 3.
