<b>Debt Forgiveness</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Forgiveness of up to \$5,000 in past-due balance owed to CSU</li> <li>• Students enrolled full time (12 credit hours or more) may have up to \$5,000 forgiven (\$2,500 over 2 terms)</li> <li>• Students enrolled part time (less than 12 credit hours) may have up to \$2,500 forgiven (\$1,250 over 2 terms)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Forgiveness of up to \$5,000 in past-due balance owed to CSU or one of the OCCC partners listed at <a href="http://ohiocollegecomeback.org">ohiocollegecomeback.org</a></li> <li>• Students needing one term's worth of credits to complete their degree can have \$5,000 debt cancelled in a single term</li> <li>• Students needing more than one terms worth of credits to complete their degree can have up to \$2,500 canceled after completing the first semester and an additional \$2,500 canceled after completing a second semester</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Up to \$2,000 grant to cover past-due balance at any Ohio institution to facilitate enrollment at Cleveland State</li> <li>• Funds will be issued directly to the institution where the debt was originally incurred by College Now</li> </ul>
<b>Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student must have been enrolled at CSU, and have stopped attending at least 2 terms (at least one spring and one fall)</li> <li>• Must owe a debt of no more than \$5,000 to Cleveland State University</li> <li>• Cannot previously have received any debt cancellation through SCDF or OCCC programs</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must have been enrolled in one of the Compact's participating institutions, and have stopped attending least 2 terms (at least one spring and one fall)</li> <li>• Must owe a certified debt of \$5,000 or less to one of the Compact institutions (cannot owe a balance to more than one college or university)</li> <li>• Must have debt that is certified to the Office of the Attorney General, and the account is NOT assigned to a special counsel</li> <li>• Cannot currently be involved in any bankruptcy proceedings</li> <li>• Cannot currently be enrolled in an associate or bachelor's degree or certificate program at any Compact institution or non-participating institution</li> <li>• Cannot previously have received the maximum debt cancellation through the Compact</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must have resided in Cuyahoga County for at least 1 year</li> <li>• Must have been previously enrolled at a public higher education institution located in Ohio</li> <li>• Must have previously incurred institutional debt preventing continued progression to certificate, degree or credential (not including federal student loan debt)</li> <li>• Must meet federal Pell Grant income eligibility requirements through submission of a Student Aid Report or Institutional Award Letter</li> <li>• Non-attendance for at least one Fall or Spring term</li> <li>• Must meet all admission criteria for selected program if not a former CSU student</li> <li>• Non-attendance for at least one Fall or Spring term</li> <li>• Must meet all admission criteria for selected program if not a former CSU student</li> </ul>
