Billing Service Fee	\$50.00
Collection Fee	\$200.00 maximum, based on account balance
E-Learning Fee	\$25.00 per credit hour
Engineering Fee, Business Fee	\$17.00 per credit hour
Late Payment Fee (for students not on a payment plan)	\$100 per month
Late Registration / Late Add (after the end of the term)	Out of state (international) fees plus \$200
Returned Check / Returned E-Check / Returned Credit Card	\$30.00 (plus other applicable late fees)
RTA U-Pass Fee (required for each semester)	\$57.50 if enrolled in 1 or more credit hours on main campus

Upon enrollment, all students will be added to a 5-month budget payment plan for the Fall and Spring semesters (a 3-month plan for Summer). Effective Fall 2024, the University's official refund schedule has changed.
