Follow this guide to easily remote to your work computer once you're connected to the vpn.

1. Note your office computer name by click start, right-clicking computer and left clicking properties. Record you full computer name for use later.



2. On the left hand side click the remote settings link and make sure Allow connections from computers running any version of remote desktop is selected and click ok
