

# **Reimporting VPN Profiles on Windows 10**

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Reimporting your OpenVPN profile may solve some authentication issues you may experience when attempting to connect to the VPN. This process is also necessary if the client certificate within your profile has expired.

#### Step 1

Launch OpenVPN Connect.

Right-click the OpenVPN Connect icon in the taskbar.



Hover over Import and click From Server...



### Step 2

When prompted for a server name, enter **openvpn.csuohio.edu** and click **Continue**.

Enter your CSU ID and password, then click **Connect**.

### Step 4

A notification will appear in the lower right portion of your screen indicating your profile has been imported successfully.



You can now connect to the VPN as you normally would.
