



Show your Cleveland State spirit with a viking-themed pumpkin!

- 1. Cut a circle/oval around the top stem of your pumpkin large enough to clean out the pumpkin with a tool, and clean out its guts
- 2. Cut slits about 1-2 inches long along the edges of the stencil at intervals of about 2 inches. This will help the stencil curve around the pumpkin.
- 3. Tape the stencil onto the surface, from multiple sides to ensure it won't move.
- 4. Transfer the stencil onto the pumpkin by 1) using a pointed tool or pushpin to poke holes along the stencil design, or 2) trace and cut the stencil to score the design lightly onto the pumpkin.
- Remove the stencil from the pumpkin, and rub some flour, cornstarch, or baking soda around the area so the dots or lines are more visible.
- 6. Carefully carve the pumpkin. Always make sure to not carve towards your fingers, or body!
- 7. Place a light inside the pumpkin and display your Viking Pride!


